Your County Councillor John Fitter writes...

Greetings dear readers of the Colan Companion.

I suspect even the gardeners among our readers will be saying that perhaps for the moment we could do with some more sunshine more akin to the month of July and August, still my worry about a water shortage for Cornwall, as written in a previous edition of the Companion, is proving to be a gloom and doom, or so it would seem for this year at least.

One thing that does not seem to change, and indeed this year it would seem to be worse them ever, and that is the traffic and the log jams in and around Qunitrell Downs. I am advised that the street works in and around the Bishops School and Tretherras College could only be done in the summer schools holiday time, due to the length of time needed to complete the works part of which involved pedestrian road safety measures.

Colan Parish is once again hosting the temporary Park and Ride which has been situated across the road from the Hendra Tourist Park, this is a much more suitable location them last year which was located down near the railway line, that was more of a park and walk especially as people were expected to walk up and catch the normal service bus into Newquay, this is a much better service with a regular bus service to tie in with the Park and Ride element.

Senior Officers of Cornwall Council along with the Cabinet members of the ruling group are in the process of setting the budget for 2024/2025, I sincerely hope that a real attempt will be made to deal with the underfunding of the Cornwall Council Countryside access team as highlighted by members of Cornwall's Local Access Forum, there is serious shortage of staff and in some cases delays of up to 10 to 12 years in dealing with blocked Public rights of ways, The Council have a statutory duty to ensure that these cases are dealt with in a timely manner and clearly are failing in this task, along with other statutory duties connected with this service. This is

not acceptable, our network of public rights of way along with our coastal footpaths are one of the jewels in our crown, very much cherished by residents and visitors, and as we are aware, some of our inland footpaths have a history and status going back hundreds of years so are worthy of special protection, with sufficient staff to provide it, to that end that I am delighted to note that the Chief Executive Kate Kennally of Cornwall Council is already carrying out a bottom -up approach to redesign the service to cope with the immense work load that the service is attempting to deal with.

I am pleased to learn that the Leader of Cornwall Council Cllr Linda Taylor has been meeting with other Celtic Nations to continue the links set up by the former leader of Cornwall Council Cllr Julian Germans, it is wonderful that we continue to celebrate these historical links, and I am delighted that Tory Group on the Council have realized the damage done by that ill-fated referendum, by going to Rennes in Brittany and signing the declaration of Rennes they continue to promote and strengthen the links with our European neighbours. Long may they continue.
