DENZELL DOWNS COMMUNITY BENEFIT FUND for the Parishes of St Mawgan in Pydar and Colan

Fund Overview

The Denzell Downs Wind Farm has around £17,500 available per year for community projects which will be split equally between the Parishes of St Mawgan in Pydar and Colan, in Cornwall.

The Fund allows groups to apply for grants between £250 and £8,750.

There is one round to apply to each year.

The application deadline for 2024 is Wednesday 20th March (decisions end May 2024).

Project Purpose

The Fund is open to community projects which are located within the Parish boundaries of St Mawgan in Pydar and Colan in the Cornwall Council division of St Mawgan and Colan.

Eligible Organisations

Eligible organisations, who can apply for funding include:

- Charities and voluntary / community groups
- The Parish Councils
- Schools and educational establishments
- Social enterprises (including credit unions, cooperatives, social firms, community-owned enterprises, community interest companies and development trusts) provided they operate on a not-for-profit basis and have a minimum of three unrelated Directors.

Applicants need to have a written constitution, a set of rules, or a governing document and a bank or building society account held in the name of the organisation in place before applying for a grant. Organisations that have already received a grant from the Fund **can** apply for further grants each year.

Applications to the Fund need to be made using the online form available via GrantScape's website. Alternative arrangements can be made for people with specific communication needs.
